This first Regional S.O.I. is scheduled to take place on Saturday, June 28, 2025 at the Harrisburg Masonic Temple, 2701 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Harrisburg, Pa. 17111. The Grand Council Regional Instructors of Work will be overseeing the schedule and the Degree/Ritual guidance.

This new Regional School of Instruction will move each year so that several areas of the state will be able to host this event and all IC’s will have an opportunity to attend & participate. We are encouraging all Officers of all the Councils in the immediate surrounding areas to attend this important school. Casual dress will be encouraged.

The schedule for the day will be the following:

- 8:15 AM to 9:00 AM Sign-in, Coffee & doughnuts available
- 9:00 AM - 10:00 AM Opening, Closing & business of the Council
- 10:00 AM - 10:30 AM Council of Sorrow & Table Council (open & closed)
- 10:30 AM- 11:15 AM Election & Installation of Officers
- 11:15 AM – Noon Receiving the PDDGM & MPGM

We are encouraging all PDDGM’s to attend if they are able. The PDDGM’s of Region B (Districts 4, 5 & 7) are required to attend. All Ritual questions are to be directed to the Ritualistic Instructors present. This is a great way to “firm up” your Council’s ritual and participate in a Regional School of Instruction atmosphere.

I hope that you will continue your Cryptic journey and renew your Council proficiency by attending this School of Instruction. There will be not Recorders Seminar offered at this event. We will be rotating this Statewide School of Instruction each year to a different Region (East, West & Central). This way all IC’s from all Councils can participate without having to travel long distances.

The PDDGM’s from Districts 4, 5 & 7 are requested to select a Council (or team) from within your District to perform the assigned rituals for the school. Other IC’s from the other Councils can join in if they need the practice or want specific assistance.
